The Manitoba Metis Federation (MMF) is undertaking consultation meetings within all 7 MMF Regions to hear from our Métis Citizens and harvesters about their perspectives on night hunting and night lighting in Manitoba.

As an Aboriginal and Indigenous People, we have the unextinguished right to harvest though our preferred means including night hunting and night lighting. We as a Community have the collective decision-making ability to determine whether we choose to exercise our right to harvest at night.

We are asking our Métis Citizens, and Métis Harvesters to provide their input on what our next steps should be.
