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CITIZENSHIP/HARVESTER IDENTIFICATION CARD APPLICATION INFORMATION

Dear Applicant

The Manitoba Metis Federation Board of Directors is pleased you are considering a Citizenship card and/or a Harvester Identification card with the MMF. We thank you for participating in this process designed to protect our Métis identity and strengthen our Métis Nation.

There are 4 different options of Metis Identification cards you can apply for with this application form.

1. **Individual Citizenship (New)** - never before held a Citizenship card with the MMF.
2. **Individual Citizenship (Confirmation)** - confirming existing Citizenship to ensure file information meets the new constitutional requirements.
3. **Children Citizenship** - parent or guardian apply for a minor
4. **Metis Harvester Identification** – Metis Harvesting Institute that is based in Metis Traditions and knowledge. (This applicant is required to be a resident of Manitoba.)

The MMF has developed an “objectively verifiable process” to identify both a Métis Citizen and a Métis Harvester. As part of this process the applicant must:

1. *Self-identify as Métis:* The application for MMF Citizenship or Harvester Identification card provides an objective and verifiable way of self-identifying as a Métis. The application process, and the subsequent issuance of cards, protect our Métis rights by preventing non-Métis from wrongly claiming and abusing our self government and harvesting rights;
2. *Show an ancestral connection to the Historic Métis Community:* In order to objectively verify the ancestral connection to the Historic Métis Nation, applicants in the MMF must submit a copy of their own Métis genealogy, or a family member’s Métis genealogy, and the required supporting evidentiary documents;
3. *Be accepted by the contemporary Manitoba Métis Community:* An objectively verifiable means of showing acceptance by Métis Nation’s Manitoba Métis Community is to have the MMF, as its duly elected self-government representative, issue you an MMF Citizenship (also known as citizen) card or MMF Métis Harvester Identification card through the application process.

In order to meet this “objectively verifiable process,” this package contains the required application forms.

SECTION I; INSTRUCTIONS

1. In **Section II** please check the boxes that correspond with your application(s)
2. All applicants, both Citizenship and Harvester, must complete **Sections II - V** in this Citizenship/Harvester Application Package. These sections are:

- II.** Citizenship/Harvester Personal Information Section (refer to page 3 of this package);
- III.** Declaration for Citizenship Card Section (refer to page 4);
- IV.** Authorization and Request for Release of Information Section (refer to page 5);
- V.** Privacy Statement Section (refer to page 8).

Note: If Citizenship is the only card you want, skip step 3 below (Section VI)

All Citizenship/Harvester Identification card applicants are to complete the forms provided in this package. Any incomplete applications will not be accepted.

3. In addition to completing the above sections, to apply for your MMF Metis Harvester Identification card complete **Section VI**

Note: Any applications received for a Harvester card are currently reserved for Manitoba residents only.

- VI.** Declaration for Harvester Identification Card Section (refer to page 9).

4. Obtain your genealogy including supporting evidentiary documents:

- a. You must provide an official genealogy that identifies a Métis Nation Ancestor. This evidence of Historic Métis Nation Ancestry along with supporting evidentiary documents must be completed by an acceptable recognized genealogical institution.

If the genealogy does not have the applicant's name on it, the applicant must provide proof of attached lineage with a copy of a birth certificate with parents' names or an official baptism certificate listing the parents' names.

- b. Government-issued photo identification as well as a birth certificate or official baptismal certificate with your parent's names are required by the institution completing your genealogy
- c. A recognized genealogy can be obtained from the following genealogical institution:

If you have a genealogy produced by a genealogical institution not mentioned above please contact Central Registry Office at MMF Home Office 204-568-8474 for a determination as to whether it will be acceptable.

5. Have the Local Executive sign the **MMF Signature section** (refer to page 10) in this package. The MMF Regional Office can provide you with the contact information for the Local in your area.

6. When Steps 1 through 5 above have been completed, call your Regional Office to make an appointment for processing by the Regional Committee.

If the application is complete and accepted, your picture will be taken, and the \$10 processing fee will be collected. The Regional Office will process your application and forward it to Central Registry Office at MMF Home Office where it will be subject to final approval and forwarded to a secure facility for further processing.

I declare that I am a "Métis", of "Historic Métis Nation Ancestry," and a Citizen of the Manitoba Métis Community as per the following Manitoba Metis Federation Inc. Constitutional definition:

- 1.1 "Métis" means a person who self-identifies as Métis, is distinct from other Aboriginal peoples, is of Historic Métis Nation ancestry, and is accepted by the Métis Nation.
- 1.2 "Historic Métis Nation" means the Aboriginal people then known as Métis or Half-breeds who resided in the Historic Métis Nation Homeland.
- 1.3 "Historic Métis Nation Homeland" means the area of land in west central North America used and occupied as the traditional territory of the Métis or Half-breeds as they were then known.
- 1.4 "Métis Nation" means the Aboriginal people descended from the Historic Métis Nation which is now comprised of all Métis Nation citizens and is one of the "aboriginal peoples of Canada" within the meaning of s.35 of the Constitution Act 1982.
- 1.5 "Distinct from other Aboriginal peoples" means distinct for cultural and nationhood purposes.

I agree that I must provide a copy of my birth certificate with parents' names and/or official baptismal certificate. As well as, my or a family member's Métis genealogy with supporting documents which include documents linking to the genealogy provided showing that I am Métis, of Historic Métis Nation Ancestry, and a member of the Manitoba Metis Community

I certify that the foregoing information is true and accurate. I acknowledge that providing false information is grounds for termination of Citizenship and/or the Metis Harvester Identification card. I confirm the attached documents, and other documentation and information supplied by me, are to the best of my knowledge, reliable and authentic, and would qualify me as "Métis", meet "Historic Métis Nation Ancestry" and the Manitoba Métis Community Citizenship requirements.

I understand that the Central Registry Office of the MMF reserves the right to question any documentation or information provided as part of this application process. Applications will be subject to review before approval or rejection.

I hereby authorize and grant permission to the MMF to conduct document verification with the appropriate organizations and/or agencies if necessary for the sole purpose of confirming ancestry concerning application for Citizenship with the MMF and or Metis Harvester Identification card.

In the case that, I have applied for and have been issued an Metis Harvester Identification card, in the event that I am charged, have property seized, or am under investigation for exercising my aboriginal harvesting rights, I agree and authorize the MMF to request such information as required to determine the nature of such charges, seizures, and /or investigations, and hereby authorize Manitoba and Canada to release such information and documentation to the MMF and its representatives in respect to such charges, seizures, and/or investigations.

SECTION V; MMF PRIVACY STATEMENT

In applying for Citizenship with the MMF and/or Metis Harvester Identification card, you have entrusted our registries with your personal information, and we are committed to protecting this information. We need to collect a certain amount of personal information from you in order to enroll you, keep in touch with you, and fulfill our mandate and our responsibilities to you as a Member and/or Harvester of the MMF. You in turn have a right to expect us to treat your personal information with the care and respect it deserves.

We hereby pledge to use, maintain, and protect your personal information responsibly and in accordance with the highest privacy principles and standards, as enshrined in Canadian Federal and Provincial privacy laws.

What personal information do we collect about you?

Personal information is any information about you as an identifiable person. The personal information we collect about you is what you yourself either give to us directly or expressly permit others to give us. We do not collect your personal information from any source without your knowledge and consent.

Mostly, it is the information you provide either on, or along with, the forms you fill out in applying for Citizenship and/or Metis Harvester Identification card. Once you are enrolled, we keep records of your use of our services or your participation in any programs we sponsor. We will also keep records of any responses you may voluntarily provide to surveys or questionnaires we send out in future.

Most of the personal information we collect is information we need to have for essential registry purposes. Sometimes, however, we may ask you for information for related, but non-essential purposes — for example, information about your knowledge or experience of Métis cultural practices and traditional lore. Whenever we consider any information we request to be non-essential, we always let you know that it is optional and your response is strictly voluntary. Whenever we consider the information to be essential, you can rest assured that we collect only the amount and types that we need to fulfill the purpose at hand.

How do we intend to use your personal information?

We use your personal information only for purposes that we consider reasonable and consistent with our mandate and our obligations to our Members and Harvesters. This may include the following:

- Processing applications, tracing ancestry, and determining eligibility for Citizenship certification and providing Citizenship cards.
- Maintaining the Citizenship registries.
- Compiling and issuing voter lists for MMF elections.
- Communicating with our members.
- Determining a person's eligibility to be a candidate for elected or appointed office with the MMF.
- Providing information to Regional and Local executives as necessary for them to fulfill their objectives and obligations to their members.
- Verifying status and eligibility for Métis-specific programs, services, and job placements (with the express consent of the individual when the request comes from affiliates or other third parties).
- Determining if applicant is on any Indian Registries
- Conducting research into cultural practices and traditional lore.

- Conducting Métis-specific research on such topics as health, housing, demographics, education, training and employment (such research does not involve or result in the identification of individuals).
- Generating non-personal statistical data and reports.
- Conducting the day-to-day business of the Central Registry Office.
- Should we decide in the future to use your personal information for any additional purpose, we will first take reasonable steps to inform you and seek your consent.

With what third parties do we share your personal information?

As a general rule, we use your personal information only within our own organization — that is, our central registry office and its associated MMF Regional/Local offices. We share personal information with outsiders only on a very limited basis and only as necessary to fulfill our stated purposes. ***We never sell, lease or trade our Member or Harvester's personal information.***

It is sometimes necessary for us to share some of your personal information with service providers whom we hire to help us carry out our responsibilities to you. For example, we contract with a firm that distributes our communications materials.

We regularly share personal information in our course of our registry activities. Your full knowledge and consent is requested on the “*Authorization and Request for Release of Information*” form (see page 5 of this package). These third parties include:

- **Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada:** When you apply for a Citizenship or Metis Harvester Identification card, we ask you to sign an authorization for us to verify with AANDC that you are not on the Indian Register.
- **Relatives:** We ask for your consent to allow your supporting genealogical documentation to be used by your relatives in making applications of their own. Denying consent will not affect your application or your standing with the MMF.
- **Genealogical Organizations:** we seek your authorization to confirm ancestral documentation submitted with your application.

Whenever we transfer personal information to third parties, we give them only as much as is required for the purpose at hand. We also ensure, by means such as contract clauses, that the third parties keep the information confidential, protect it with appropriate safeguards, retain it only as long as necessary to fulfill the purpose, and generally treat it in accordance with privacy standards comparable to our own.

Storing your personal information

We keep your personal information in our Central Registry Office at the MMF Home Office, 150 Henry Avenue and at your MMF Regional Office. We will retain it on file there as long as you remain an MMF Member and/or Harvester.

We take the security of your personal information very seriously. We are instituting numerous physical, organizational, and technological safeguards to protect our Citizenship and Harvester lists, both paper and electronic, against loss, theft, and unauthorized access, disclosure, copying, use, and modification. We regularly review our security needs to ensure that our safeguards continue to be appropriate and equal to the task.

Our registry staff receives privacy training and is aware of the need for confidentiality and security of any personal information they may handle in the course of their daily work.

What are your rights regarding your personal information?

You have a right to withdraw your consent at any time to any of the uses or disclosures listed above, subject to legal or contractual restrictions and reasonable notice. Depending on the nature of the use or disclosure in question, withdrawing consent may have consequences affecting your Citizenship and/or Metis Harvester Identification card. We will inform you of any such possible consequences.

You have a right to be given access to whatever personal information about you we have on file, to challenge its accuracy and completeness, and to have it amended as appropriate. Our policy is to respond to access requests within 30 days, at minimal cost to requestors.

You have a right to be informed about our policies and practices with regard to your personal information. We will be pleased to respond to all inquiries.

If you believe we have been in any way remiss in handling your personal information, please inform the Central Registry Office and we will investigate and attempt to resolve all complaints to the satisfaction of all those involved.

How can you exercise your privacy rights?

- I understand that my participation in the MMF Metis Harvesting Initiative, which includes the use of the Card, is an exercise of my Métis Rights. I accept, and agree to abide by, the MMF Constitution and Bylaws, and all MMF procedures and policies governing the use of the Card, including the MMF Metis Laws of the Harvest.
- I certify that the foregoing is true and accurate. I acknowledge and agree that if the information contained in this application form is subsequently determined to be false, the Card issued by MMF will be deemed invalid and will be revoked by MMF.
- I acknowledge and agree that the use of my Card does not guarantee me protection from seizures, charges, or prosecution pursuant to federal and provincial laws. I understand that in such event, MMF may provide me with legal assistance provided that I am charged for exercising my aboriginal harvesting rights, and that there is no allegation that I have contravened and safety, health, or other applicable conservation laws.
- I hereby release and discharge MMF, its officers and employees, of and from all manner of action, claims, demands, and damages whatsoever which I have or otherwise hereafter may have for or by reason of any injury, loss or damage arising from the issuance of a Card and/or the use of such Card by me.
