The Louis Riel Institute seeks to fill **one full time permanent Education Support Worker** position located in **Winnipeg, MB**. Remuneration is \$26,208 - \$28,314 per annum, depending on qualification and experience. Start date as soon as possible.

Education Support Worker

Reporting to the Standing Tall Coordinator, the Education Support Worker will monitor and support middle year students and their families to ensure a positive schooling experience. He/she will receive daily directions from the classroom teacher and with the support of the School Administrator; will provide Aboriginal students with academic, emotional, and cultural guidance. The Worker will include parental involvement to enhance the probability of success and to assist with the well-being of the entire family unit.

- Knowledge of Metis culture
- Willing to work with middle year students
- Ability to work independently with little direct supervision
- Ability to maintain effective working relationships with students, team members, parents and those encountered in the course of employment

- Demonstrated ability to use judgement when dealing with sensitive issues
- An active member of the school community
- Acceptable criminal records check and child abuse registry check information
- Ability to monitor and record students growth and attendance
- Ability to write informal reports
