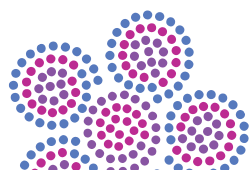

What is Palliative Care?

Palliative care is health care provided to people of any age living with a progressive, lifelimiting illness.

The goal of palliative care is to manage symptoms, relieve suffering and promote comfort while supporting the physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs of individuals and their families.

Where is Palliative Care Provided?

In most cases, individuals can choose to receive palliative care where they are most comfortable. This can be:

- ∞ Home
- ∞ Hospitals
- ∞ Long-term care facilities
- ∞ Hospices

Palliative Care at Home

Additional supports are available for those who are receiving palliative care at home.

Palliative Care Drug Program

This program offers deductible-free medication coverage for those receiving palliative care at home.

To be eligible, individuals must:

- ∞ Be a resident of Manitoba with a valid Manitoba Health card.
- ∞ Have a palliative diagnosis from a healthcare provider.
- ∞ Have their healthcare provider submit an application to the regional palliative care coordinator.

Respite Care

Respite care provides relief for families caring for a loved one at home. It includes:

- ∞ Short-term stays (up to two weeks) at a healthcare facility

Note: A subsidized daily fee applies
