WHY THIS WORK MATTERS

This initiative seeks to help identify, honour and remember Red River Métis children who attended Residential Schools.

- Preserve Red River Métis histories and community knowledge
- Restore names, family connections and stories
- Support research into schools, sites and related places
- Guide respectful remembrance, ceremony and commemoration

Survivor and community knowledge is essential.

Your experience may help ensure that children, families and communities are recognized in the historical record.

WHAT YOU MAY WISH TO SHARE

- Names and stories of children who attended Residential Schools
- Family histories, kinship connections and community memories
- Photographs, letters, records or other historical documents
- Knowledge of former school locations and related places
- Information about cemeteries, burial sites or unmarked graves
- Guidance on respectful remembrance, ceremony and commemoration

HOW YOU CAN TAKE PART
